- Twenty-nine private patient rooms include space for parents to stay with their baby 24-hours a day.
- NICU suites are designed to accommodate twins and triplets.
- Individual nurse work stations will be located between patient rooms for an optimal level of care at the bedside.
- A family room will provide a quiet, comfortable respite space as well as a kitchenette for parents and families, making their stay feel a little more like home.
